How to setup a Glacier on your wifi:

- Initially, you must plug the Glacier in using the ethernet cable that came with it. (be careful to plug the side with the stripped plastic over the eject tab into the Glacier, see image below. It can be difficult to push down the eject tab on the side without the stripped plastic when you remove the cord from the Glacier later)



You can either plug it directly into a router, or, if you have a mac with an ethernet port, you can turn on internet sharing in system preferences (share wifi over ethernet) and plug the glacier directly into your computer.

- Then plug in the power to the glacier. After a short delay, you should see an ip address show briefly on the screen before the poem is shown, write it down.
- -type into the address field that IP address in your internet browser of choice. (http://xxx.xxx.xxx.
- You should see a page with a dropdown menu on which you can select your wifinetwork and a text box to type in your password.

 Select your wifi, type in your password, and click submit.
- The page should refresh and at the top it should say "Status: connected to wifi"
- At this point you can unplug the ethernet cable from the glacier, you can now install it anywhere, within the range of your wifi network, you only need to plug into electricity.
